Mt. Olive teen pair charged in sex assault on intoxicated girl

MOUNT OLIVE—Two teenage boys have been charged with sexually assaulting a girl who was incapacitated after having consumed alcohol, police said.

At 8:22 p.m. Saturday, police received a phone call from a woman who said her 15-year-old daughter might be intoxicated at a home in the Flanders section of the township.

Officers responded to the residence and came into contact with a 16-year-old male resident and his 15-year-old male friend, according to Cpl. Eric Anthony, a spokesman for the department.

Police found the girl incoherent in an upstairs bedroom, according to po-

lice. The girl was transported to a local hospital to be treated for impairment due to alcohol consumption.

Police then investigated how the teenagers obtained the alcohol and determined that the boys had sexually assaulted the girl as she lay incapacitated by alcohol consumption, Anthony said.

The 16-year-old was charged Wednesday with first-degree aggravated sexual assault of an incapacitated victim, aggra-

vated sexual assault and endangering the welfare of a child.

The 15-year-old was charged with first-degree aggravated sexual assault of an incapacitated victim.

Both were in the Morris County Juvenile Detention Center, Anthony said. The names of those charged were not released because of their age.

Members of the Mount Olive Police Detective Bureau were assisted by the Morris County Prosecutors Office in the investigation.
